
Office Hours...

Tuesday Report Sheet...

Each Tuesday, students receive a newsletter, "Mr. P's Note Home," along with a "Tuesday Report Sheet." This sheet serves as a weekly communication between school and home. On Tuesday evenings, parents and students are asked to check grades (Infinite Campus) and LiveSchool for effort. The back of the sheet has a form that may be used to organize student academic needs such as taking care of missing assignments or late work, making corrections to not yet mastered skills, or scheduling retake/re-do needs. Students

should return the signed Tuesday sheet on Wednesday morning.

More from Mr. P...

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1. LIVESCHOOL: Our total class points (as of September 29) are 9,726! Awesome!

- 2. **CLASS TWEETS:** Text **on @MeigsMagnet** to 404-04. This will allow all subscribers to follow our class on Twitter without necessarily being a Twitter user.
- 3. **MISSING WORK:** This is the last call for any missing assignments to be submitted and graded for credit. Procedures are clearly established now. After this, late work will be completed for learning purposes but will not necessarily be given full credit.
- 4. **TECH TASKS:** Students must complete each day's Tech Task (Google Form) as homework if it is not done in class that day. Students must submit the Tech Task by 8:00AM the following school day. After that time, the Tech Task is late and will have to be completed as a written assignment on notebook paper. It is very wise to save the responses on e-mail, in a Google Doc, or take a screenshot of the Tech Task.
- 5. **HOMEWORK GRADES**: Any homework not completed and submitted on time will be given a ZERO. ZEROS in Infinite Campus (marked as homework) may not be made up for credit. It is important that all HW be completed. Late HW may still be completed, but without a grade.
