




Ancient china ABC book

Education in traditional China was dominated by the keju (civil service examination system), which began developing around 400 A.D. and reached its height during the Tang Dynasty




F- filial piety

Kung fu is a primarily unarmed Chinese martial art resembling karate. And was created in china




L- legalism

M- Mandate of heaven


The 'Mandate of Heaven' established the idea that a ruler must be just to keep the approval of the gods


N- Networks

Networks included trade routes like the Silk Road, The Silk Road was an ancient trade route that linked the Western world with the Middle East and Asia.




0- Oracle Bones
