Research the author of *Freak the Mighty*, Rodman Philbrick, and complete an eightframe flow chart about his life. Write the event in each box and draw a picture for each event.

•Kevin has Morquio Syndrome. Research this condition and create an informational brochure on the syndrome. Include definition, symptoms, people who are more risk for the condition, exams and tests done to diagnose the condition, treatments, support groups, outlook (prognosis), and possible complications.

•Kevin is an avid reader of the tales of King Arthur. Research the legend of King Arthur and create a timeline of his life with eight events. For each event, include one picture.

•Max and Kevin encounter bullies throughout the novel. Create a brochure to inform people how to deal with bullies. Include signs of a bully, what to do when being bullied, how to react to bullies, and how to help prevent bullying.
